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Koleksi Galeri Nasional

PERJALANAN SENI RUPA MODERN INDONESIA

Latar Belakang

Koleksi seni rupa di Galeri Nasional Indonesia berjumlah sekitar 1500 karya, berangka tahun dari 1867 hingga 1997. Kumpulan karya ini, dengan berbagai kekurangannya, merupakan bagian dari representasi perjalanan seni rupa di Indonesia. Unsur kekurangan dari koleksi Galeri Nasional terletak pada pemilihan karya yang tidak dapat memenuhi seluruh kebutuhan yang mendai kelengkapan dan kesempurnaan perjalanan seni rupa di Indonesia. Khususnya, dalam kerangka memberikan gambaran kualitas karya terbaik dan memenuhi gambaran realitas atau aktualitas penandaan konteks perjalanan sejarah seni rupa di Indonesia. Patut kiranya untuk disadari bahwa, kemungkinan karya-karya terbaik dan teraktaul dari representasi perjalanan seni rupa di Indonesia telah tersebar di beberapa tempat (museum, galeri, dan kolektor). Kendati demikian, pihak Galeri Nasional Indonesia tetap berupaya untuk terus melengkapi dan menyempurnakan koleksinya, hingga di suatu saat kelak Galeri Nasional Indonesia benar-benar bisa menjawab kekurangannya dan tetap menjadi wahana studi bagi masyarakat untuk mengenali perjalanan seni rupa Indonesia yang dimaksud.

MODERN INDONESIAN FINE ARTS, A JOURNEY THROUGH TIME

Background

Fine arts collections at the National Gallery of Indonesia of approximately 1500 art works, covering the period of 1867 to 1997, despite their shortcomings, are part of a representation of fine arts in Indonesia. The shortcomings stem from the selection of the art works which could not meet the requirements identifying the completeness and perfection of the passage of fine arts in Indonesia. Specifically, within the framework of giving a qualitative description of the best art works and meeting the reality or actuality in identifying the historical context of fine arts in Indonesia. It is worthwhile to know of the possibility that the best and actual art works representing the passage of Indonesian fine arts through time were scattered in various venues, such as museums, galleries, and collectors. Nevertheless, the National Gallery of Indonesia continuously endeavors to complete and perfect its collections. It is expected that one day in the near future the National Gallery of Indonesia could really cover the shortcomings and keep them as a vehicle for the society to comprehend the streams of the Indonesian fine arts.
